slamic Values & Our Responsibilities



Happy New Islamic Year of 1434 Hijra.

With the sighting of the new moon the Islamic New Year is ushered in. The first month, Muhamam, is a month of great reward and virtue. Muharram itself means 'sacred' and is from those months which have been mentioned. as being so in the Hoty Qur'an. Although the month of Muharram is a sacred month as a whole, the 10th of Muharram is the most secred among all its days. The day is named 'Ashurah'. It is one of the most important and blessed days of Allah in the Islamic calendar.

According to the Holy companion Ibn Abbas (RA), when the Holy Prophet (PBUH) migrated to Madinah, he found that the Jews of Madinah used to fast on the 10th day of Muhamam. They said that it was the day on which the Holy Prophet Musa (AS) and his followers crossed the Red Sea miraculously, and the Pharach was drowned. in its water. On hearing this from the Jews, the Hoty Prophet (PBUH) said, "We are more dosely related to Musa than you." So the Prophet (PBUH) directed the Muslims to fast on the day of Ashura (Abu Davcod). However it is important to either fast on the ninth and the tenth or the tenth and the eleventh of Muhamam.

The martyrdom of Syedena Hussin (RA) on the same day was indeed a great tragedy. The dash between Syedena Hussain (RA) and Yazid was not for acquiring power but the fact of the matter is that Karbala. represents the clash between the forces of truth and falsehood & Hussain (RA) was all set for embracing (martyrdom, not power. The act of Syedena Hussain teaches us to be righteous and stand for the truth no matter how immense sacrifice is required to uphold the truth, justice and righteourness.



Lunch Box Idea

Ingredients:

1/4 dup soy sauce

14 duo tomato sauce

1 tablespoon honey 12 chloren drumettes

125g sugar snap peas, trimmed

1 large carrot, cut into sticks

2 calery stalks, out into sticks

Method:

- Preheat the oven to 200°C Line a baking tray with foil.






